Colin Fullam's V-6 Thing from Granada Hills, California

I am sending you some pictures of my car's engine and a brief description of it's power plant.

Engine: 160 hp and 185 ftlbs torque
Short Block- 1992 3.1L Chevy Lumina V6
Heads- 1984 2.8L Chevy S-10
Intake-1984 2.8L Pontiac Firebird
Headers-1984 2.8L Pontiac Fiero
Mallory Distributor

Cooling system:

Rear mounted radiator with 2 14 inch puller fans (mounted above transaxle), custom radiator side scoops built into body (above rear fenders) direct airflow across radiator. Coolant flow controlled by an electric water pump.

A lot of care was taken on the engine install to make sure that the car's body was left intact and uncut. Many modifications were done to the engine to ensure proper engine compartment clearance, including the elimination of the belt driven water pump and alternator relocation. Two inch exhaust exits through factory bumper holes.
